	<p>NetSetGO is Australia’s official starter program for girls and boys aged 5-10. It gives a positive introduction to netball and teaches the basics while having fun, keeping active & staying safe. NetSetGO is divided into 3 tiers: NET – 5-6 year olds and beginners SET – 7-8 year olds and intermediates GO – 9-10 year olds and experienced</p> <p>Info link - Suncorp NetSetGO</p> <p>Once players have learnt the basic skills through NetSetGO, they can transition to club netball at any Association in Australia, or through their school. Some may like to play for fun, friendships and exercise or it may be through compulsory sport at some schools.
